

Cosmetology Training Center acknowledges that the institution signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification of Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used all funds received under the American Rescue Plan (HEERF III) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to eligible students.

Cosmetology Training Center has received \$46,237.00 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to distribute to its students.

This emergency student funding is only available to students that were enrolled and attending classes as of 3/21/2021 and have maintained Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP). Students currently on an Approved Leave of Absence are also allowed to participate in the survey and receive funds. Cosmetology Training Center disbursed funds across the student body to those who have incurred additional expenses because of campus disruption due to COVID-19. Pell eligible students received 70% of total funds and Non- Pell eligible students received 30%. Each student received a check as follows:
